Attached with our newsletter this week is some guidance from SLEEP RIGHT NORTHAMPTON to support parents and carers who are having sleep issues with their children this term.

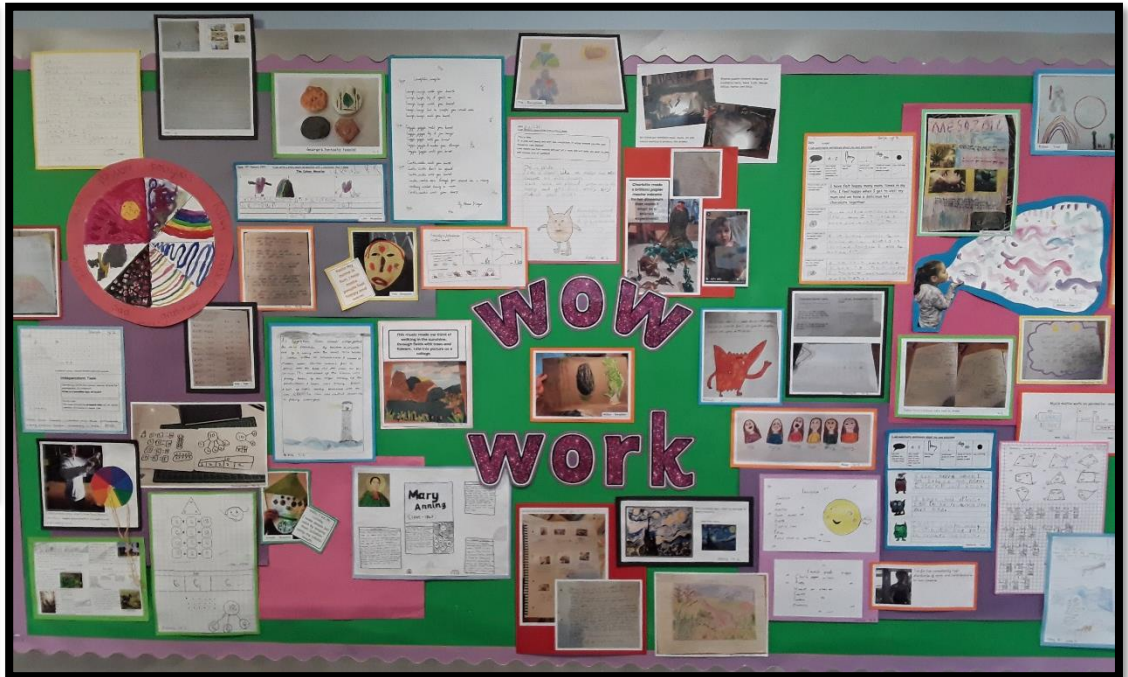


WOW WORK THIS WEEK
