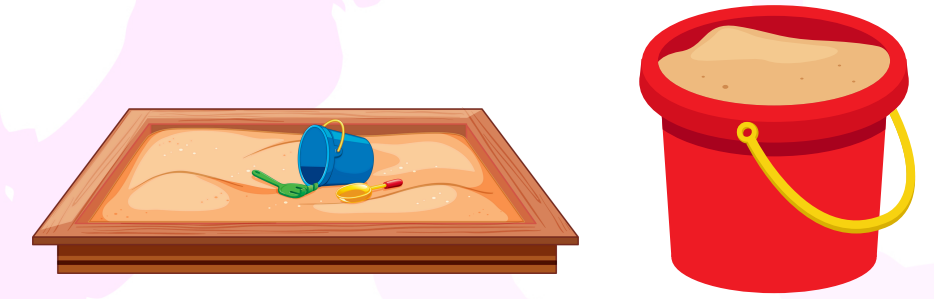

Skills	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beginning to share resources with adult support, using methods such as sand timers.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beginning to allow others to work with them, listening to each others ideas.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Take turns and share the resources independently. Work collaboratively towards the same goal.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pour sand using hands and large jugs</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pour sand using spades and shovels</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pour sand using funnels and tubes.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use a one handed tool, large shovel etc, to fill a bucket or container</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select the appropriate sized spade to fill a bucket or container - small spade for a small bucket etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be skilled in using a range of one handed tools - rake, spade, scoop etc. and use small scoops and spoons to fill cups and moulds carefully and with good hand - eye coordination.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dig with hands, spades and buckets.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dig with spades and large spoons</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dig using spoons, measuring spoons and forks.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Model using hands and simple tools.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Model with shaped containers, make a sandcastle.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use resources such as lolly sticks, twigs, and matchsticks to add definition and details to the thigs they are creating in the sand.</li> </ul>
