

Treasurers Report for year ending August 31st 2019

Firstly, the accounts have been audited and approved by an independent accountant.

In summary we have had a very busy and productive year, surpassing all budgets. We finish the year with a bank balance of £6848.68

Income

Our net income for the year was £8885.11 which is up from the previous year (£7485.64).

We ran a number of fund raising events including: the Christmas fayre raising £1353.36, child enterprise raising £1105.85 and the mudder raising £924.03. And, lets not forget the Panto which raised a phenomenal £1079.45. This event brought our school family together, I lost count of the number of parents that remarked on how privileged we were to have such a wonderful school community, and how lucky we are with our fantastic teachers.

We continue to both support school events and run a number of varied PTFA lead events throughout the year. A breakdown of the events can be seen in the Summary of Fundraising Activities.

Expenditure

Our expenditure for the year was £5,642.76 which is significantly lower than the previous year. This is due to a number of donations being put on hold until the next school year. A breakdown of the expenditure can be seen in the Donations for School Provisions.

The PTFA continues to ensure that our children benefit from trips, donating £10 per child for class trips and £350 towards the Trickle trip to Gullivers Land. The PTFA also supported the whole school summer outdoor learning by donating £500.

Our main focus this year was the purchase of iPads for £3517.

To conclude, 2019 was another fantastic year for fundraising. The events continue to be a success through the support of parents, teachers and PTFA committee members.
