## **Micro Librarian System Information**

At school we have purchased an online library system which children can electronically get out and return books in the library.

Each child will have a library card with a 4-digit number on it.

As part of the system children have their own account which they can access at home and at school.

On this account children and parents can find out about books children have got out in the library. They can see if the book is overdue or what books they have got out in the past.

Other great features include:

- 1. Writing a review about the book they are reading
- 2. Search for a particular book in the library (subject, author, title etc)
- 3. Watch authors talk about their books.
- 4. See what other people have said about a book.
- 5. Find out what the most popular books are in the library
- 6. Get suggestion on other books they could read based on the past loans.
- 7. Have access to 1000s of web links on particular subject area.
- 8. Find out which new books have arrived in the library.

To access these areas, children need to log-in to their accounts.

Username- Is their 4 digit number

Passwords- Is the same number.

There are two ways to get onto this system. On the internet or by downloading the app.

To access the internet go to : <u>https://u021081.microlibrarian.net/</u> (Currently it will only work on Internet Explorer, Firefox and Safari if Microsoft Silverlight is loaded on your laptop or PC).

To download the app on to your phone or tablet you can go to the App store or Play Store and type in iMLS or micro librarian and download (It is free!).

You then need to search for our site by typing in the school's postcode (OX17 3DN)

And then do the same as the website with the log-in and password.

If you find your child has lost their book. We ask that you find out the book's name and purchase a replacement and hand it to your class teacher, otherwise our library stock will go down and children won't be able to enjoy all our fantastic books. Thanks.
